We have the technology to feed all the people in the world yet thousands of people die of starvation everyday.



Wow!


Things that we make or create show us a part of our invisible nature. That's why we get so excited when we see something we created!

" So God created man in His Own image... male and female he created them."


Love is the power to bring two or more into Unity and Harmony.

Heavenly Father can only feel complete joy when he has a perfect object. That means we have to be the kind of people God made us to be.


A perfect object will resemble God.



To have loving relationships with people. To be good children, brothers, sisters, students, friends and ultimately get married and have a loving marriage.


Everyone wants to have a good marriage. Everyone wants their family to be a good, loving and happy family.




CREATION TWO

When we can do all of these things then God knows we are able to take on the responsibility of co-creatorship.


That makes Him so happy!!!
